

AUSEN DELEGATION TO CIPPE - CHINA

CHINA INTERNATIONAL PETROLEUM & PETROCHEMICAL & EQUIPMENT EXHIBITION

AUSEN the Australian Oil & Gas Network, supported by the State Government of Victoria, is preparing an industry capability delegation to the China International Petroleum and Petrochemical Equipment Exhibition (CIPPE) in Beijing, China on 22 – 24 March 2010.

About CIPPE

CIPPE, held every March in Beijing is known as the premier exhibition in the petroleum and petrochemical industry in China and the most important industrial show in Asia. CIPPE is held at China's largest exhibit space and attracts a high quality of exhibitors from around the world.

CIPPE also includes three additional exhibitions:

- China International Offshore Oil & Gas Exhibition
- China International Explosion Protection Electric Technology & Equipment Exhibition
- China International Petroleum & Petrochemical Electrical & Automation Exhibition

The CIPPE 2009 exhibit area covered approximately 60,000 square meters with around 1100 exhibitors from 37 countries and regions including five pavilions from the USA, Russia, Italy, Brazil, and Singapore. The exhibitors comprised 37% international companies and included 13 of the world's top 500 companies.
